Terms of Use

These are the Terms and Use conditions that govern your use of the AI Assessment Generator Tool (the “Tool”). They supplement and should be read in conjunction with the Subscription Services Terms of Use ([Discovery Education Subscription Services | Terms of Use](#)).

Please read these Terms of Use carefully to ensure that you understand each provision and obligation.

A. About the Tool:

1. The Tool is powered by an AI engine and is able to generate assessment questions. The Tool leverages two AI models developed by OpenAI and licensed by us, overlayed by proprietary prompts we developed to facilitate the generation of assessments. The models are a variant of gpt-4, a type of large language model which is a large a deep learning algorithm that can recognize, summarize, predict and generate content based on knowledge gained from datasets. We use gpt-4 to generate the assessments, determine learning objectives, and determine question accuracy. We also use text-embedding-ada-002 which measures the relatedness of text strings and can be used for search, grouping and recommendations. We use this model to convert the text extracted from source materials into embeddings that are stored in a database and used for retrieval of source material when generating assessments. 2. According to OpenAI’s terms, the OpenAI models do not use any source material you upload to improve the models unless you opt in to permit this and we have not opted in to this option. In addition, to help identify abuse, data you entered may be retained for up to 30 days, after which it will be deleted (unless otherwise required by law).
